This ordinance can be found on our website at www.athenstownship.org. Go to "Ordinances", "Code of the Township of Athens". In "Part II - General Legislation", scroll down to "Chapter 108 – Noise", and in particular, see "Fireworks" 108-4(K).

The use of public or private fireworks requires a permit from the Athens Township Chief of Police, and is only allowed between the dates of June 30th and July 8th each year. Permits are available at the Athens Township Municipal Building, 45 Herrick Ave., Sayre, PA 18840, and can also be found on our website at www.athenstownship.org under "Forms and Applications". Please allow 5 days for processing. Time limitations are specified on the applications.

We ask that you follow the safety regulations and guidelines set forth in local, state and federal legislation. Please keep in mind that some of our soldiers who have served our country with honor deal with PTSD and these displays can cause them great anxiety. Be mindful and respectful of that as you celebrate. Pets will appreciate that as well!
